The President of North Korea

Kim Il Sung, founder of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea and father of Kim Jong Il, died in 1994. In 1998, the Constitution of the DPRK was modified to make him the ***Eternal President***.

Kim Jong Il is General Secretary of the Korean Worker's Party, Supreme Commander of the Korean People's Army and Chairman of the National Defense Commission. He is the "Comrade General", "Dear Leader" or "Great Sun of the 21st Century" and actual ruler of NK.

Kim Yong Nam is President of the Supreme People's Assembly and Chairman of the Presidium, SPA. As such he accepts the credentials of foreign ambassadors, making him the *de facto* head of state.

North Korean Worship

The Korean people absolutely worship, trust and follow the General [Kim Jong Il] as God... the General is the mental pillar and the eternal sun to the Korean People. Rodong Shinmun (Workers' Daily—official organ of the Korean Workers' Party)

According to official sources, his nativity was accompanied by miraculous events—a swallow foretold his birth and a double rainbow with thunder and lightning announced it. Natural marvels are said to follow him as he travels.

North Koreans are taught to worship Kim Jong Il along with his father Kim Il Sung as supreme. The third part of this trinity is the ideology of Juche.

Reunification and Sacrifice

"I will devote myself to the sacred cause of national reunification, remaining loyal to [the Leader, Kim Jong Il]" (O Ik Je, leader of the religion of Chondokyo, as reported by the Korea Central News Agency, formal organ of the DPRK)

"Red Flag" ideology calls on the people to embrace the spirit of self-reliance [Juche], the revolutionary struggle and spirit, and to become "bullets" and "human bombs" to protect the Leader." (Juche: A Christian Study of North Korea's State Religion by Thomas J. Belke)
